**Romans 7:1-6** "... you have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another, even to Him who was raised from the dead..."

**Colossians 2:9-10** "For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power."

#### **Declaration of Intent**

#### John 14:18-21, 23, 27; 15:9-11, 16a

Romans 8:31-32, 35, 38-39 "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? <sup>35</sup> Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? <sup>38</sup> For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, <sup>39</sup> nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
