"As I reread the Gospel passages, Jesus' words are much harsher than I remember... Because we in America read certain passages over and over to the neglect of others, we start to believe that Jesus had a friendly tone all the time.... [but] When you read it all like you are reading it for the first time, you walk away going, 'Wow, He was pretty hardcore.'

Here's what I had to repent of: I had felt the need to soften a lot of Jesus' statements, because in my arrogance I thought, 'Okay Jesus, I'm not going to say that like that. Trust me, people will like You more and be more willing to accept You if I say it like this.' ... I thought I could attract more people to Jesus by hiding certain things about Him. I had to confess my arrogance."
