Work hard in your conversations to turn people away from the HOW and back to the WHO; get them thinking about Jesus Christ and considering the claims of Christ.

British pastor and author, **John Stott**, died last month at the age of 90... after pastoring more than 60 years... and writing more than 50 books... but he always kept it simple. His book *Basic Christianity* has sold 2 ½ million copies now... in 60 different languages. And while the evangelical world is sure to miss him... his friends were not limited to Christian circles alone.

In **2004** The New York Times did an article about John Stott that prompted singer Paul Simon (as in Simon & Garfunkel fame) to ask if he could meet with him. They ended up having tea together for several hours in Stott's little apartment there in London. And when they met Paul Simon started right in complaining about specific people that were a part of the religious right... but John Stott gently interrupted him and said, "I am more interested in what you think of Jesus Christ."
