 - c. How have you experienced or seen Christianity without the Holy Spirit? Why is good doctrine/teaching not enough?
 - d. In everyday life, what role does the Holy Spirit play in YOUR life?

 - a. What was new or helpful from the message about the nature of the Holy Spirit?
 - b. What difference does it make for the Holy Spirit to be a "person"?

 - d. Which ministry of the Holy Spirit stands out to you most?
