"Don't Drink the Kool-Aid" Luke 14:1-6

Luke 14:1-6 "One Sabbath, when He went to dine at the house of a ruler of the Pharisees, they were watching Him carefully.² And behold, there was a man before Him who had dropsy.³ And Jesus responded to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, 'Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath, or not?' ⁴ But they remained silent. Then He took him and healed him and sent him away.⁵ And He said to them, 'Which of you, having a son or an ox that has fallen into a well on a Sabbath day, will not immediately pull him out?' ⁶ And they could not reply to these things."

I. You need to take false teaching as seriously as God does!

A. The Bible contains vivid and powerful language in reference to false teachers.

- a. In the Old Testament...
 - "mute dogs, unable to bark" (Isa. 56:10)
 - "demented fools" (Hos. 9:7)
 - "reckless, treacherous men" (Zeph. 3:4)
- b. Jesus Himself...
 - "ravenous wolves" (Matt. 7:15)
 - "blind guides for the blind" (Matt. 15:14)
 - "hypocrites," "fools," "whitewashed tombs full of bones," "serpents," "brood of vipers" (Matt. 23:13,17,27,33)
- c. Elsewhere in the New Testament...
 - "savage wolves" (Acts 20:29)
 - "slaves of their own appetites" (Rom. 16:18)
 - "servants of Satan" (2 Cor. 11:15)

B. You don't need to "hunt" for false teachers, but you better know one when you see one.

2 Peter 2:1 "But false prophets also arose among the people, **just as there will be false teachers among you**, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction."

3 Ways To Recognize A False Teacher

1. False teachers won't speak the truth about **Jesus** (or will avoid Him altogether).

Matthew 16:15-16 "He said to them, 'But who do you say that I am?' ¹⁶ Simon Peter replied, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.'"

2 John 1:9 "Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son."

1 John 2:22 "Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son."

2. False teachers will preach a different **Gospel** than the one found in the Bible.

1 Corinthians 15:1-4 "Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, ² and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. ³ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁴ that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures."

Galatians 1:9 "As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed."

3. False teachers will not grow in **Christ-like character**.

Jude 1:11 "Woe to them! For they walked in the way of Cain and abandoned themselves for the sake of gain to Balaam's error and perished in Korah's rebellion."

Matthew 7:19-20 "Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰ Thus you will recognize them by their fruits."

II. You need to know the best way to spot a counterfeit is to study the real thing - Jesus Christ and His Word!

2 Timothy 2:15 "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, **rightly handling the word of truth**."

Questions for Personal Reflection and/or Community Group Discussion:

- 1) What in your life shows you take seriously the need to guard against false teaching?

- 4) Why is it helpful to be a part of a Community Group when it comes to keeping your life free of false teaching?
- 5) Reread 2 Timothy 2:15. What practices of Bible intake have helped you "rightly handle the word of truth"?
